

Warranties

* Pillow and Duvet Warranty terms: Gabriel Scientific OÜ ("GSOU") warrants that the pillows and duvets it supplies will be free from defects in materials and workmanship and will be fit for standard purpose for one year from the date of supply. The limited warranty term is one year beginning on the date of invoice ("the Warranty Period") and excludes normal loss of loft, defects caused by abuse, modifications, improper or insufficient maintenance, improper operation, and fair wear and tear. During the Warranty Period, GS will repair or replace, at no charge, products or parts of a product that proves defective and/or not fit for standard purpose because of improper material or workmanship, under normal use and maintenance.

**Warranty terms: Gabriel Scientific OÜ ("GSOU") warrants that the mattress it supplies will be free from defects in materials and workmanship and will be fit for standard purpose for five years from the date of supply – fair wear and tear excluded. The limited warranty term is five years beginning on the date of invoice and applies on a sliding scale – 100% YR 1, 100% YR 2, 80% Yr3, 60% Yr4, 40% Yr5 ("the Warranty Period") and excludes normal loss of loft, defects caused by abuse, modifications, improper or insufficient maintenance, improper operation, and fair wear and tear. During the Warranty Period, GS will repair or replace, at no charge, products or parts of a product that proves defective and/or not fit for standard purpose because of improper material or workmanship, under normal use and maintenance in accordance with established hospital protocols.

***Warranty terms: Gabriel Scientific OÜ ("GSOU") warrants that the mattress cover it supplies will be free from defects in materials and workmanship and will be fit for standard purpose for two years from the date of supply – fair wear and tear excluded. During the Warranty Period, GS will repair or replace, at no charge, products or parts of a product that proves defective and/or not fit for standard purpose because of improper material or workmanship, under normal use and maintenance in accordance with established hospital protocols.
